You will have the task to track your 3 friends and have them donate by November 5th.

The next page allows you to search for the Bree Eriksen Memorial Dance Award Fund and you can make a donation using your credit card from there. It is that simple. Donations for \$25 or more will receive a Canadian tax receipt (sorry for those outside of Canada...you will just have to give from the bottom of your heart!)

After that talk to your friends/co-workers about Bree and encourage 3 or as many of them to come on-line and donate as well! It is for a great cause and completely legitimate through The Calgary Foundation
