

PRIMARY SKIRT

(To be worn with regulation leotard)

REQUIREMENTS

1 Metre Material. 36" wide.
Non-Iron Vilene.
Hooks and Eyes.

SUGGESTED MATERIAL

Checked Gingham, Swiss Voile or Similar Lightweight Material.

Colour to match the regulation leotard.

TO MAKE UP

- a) Cut a 4" strip from the material for the waistband.
(2" deep when finished)
- b) Fold the remaining material in half. Cut into two pieces and cut one of these pieces in half. The larger piece will be the front of the skirt and the smaller pieces will make up the back.
- c) Seam the three pieces together leaving a 3" opening at the back. Make two rows of gathers approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ " from the top edge of the material and draw up to fit the waistband. (Allow approx. $1\frac{1}{2}$ " to length of waistband for overlapping when attaching hooks and eyes.)

The waistband should be lined with Non-Iron Vilene.

- d) Turn up hem, which should be hand stitched.

The length of the finished skirt should be approximately 3" from the floor when kneeling.

* You can make a bow for the back of the skirt with the extra material.
